SECTION ONE – THE INDIVIDUAL CHARTS

The question of whether any two individuals should or should not be married is not for an Astrologer to answer. That question belongs strictly to the two people involved. The Astrologer's task is to help the two people understand each other and to provide them with practical support and suggestions as to how their relationship can be improved and maintained. Beyond that, it's up to the couple to decide. The Astrologer's central responsibility is to describe any areas of difficulty that the couple may face, and ways in which their relationship could be made to work more effectively.

But first the task of the Astrologer is to come to grips with the uniqueness of each person. Before I consider any kind of Astrological interaction between people, the first requirement is to acquire a thorough understanding of the people as individuals. So initially I need to take a long, hard look at the two birth charts – separately.



Both Jean and Andrew have their Suns in the sign of Aries, so consciously or unconsciously, both are striving towards the development of courage. In the face of stress, obstacles and the distractions which are caused by fear, they need to sharpen their willpower. Fearlessness is not the point – rather their motto must be 'Feel the fear and do it anyway!'

To learn courage they both need to intentionally expose themselves to things that frighten or intimidate them. In doing so they will teach their unconscious Selves lessons about their own strengths – and the next

time they have to do something that frightens them, they will remember the lesson and feel less afraid.

The resource of the Ram of Aries is, paradoxically, courage! Bravery already exists in their natures, but it must be brought out by a series of scary circumstances before they become fully aware of it. Whatever the nature of the Ogres that these two Aries must face, the principle is always the same – face enough Ogres without flinching, and they will become a lot more courageous than they were.

The 'cardinal sin' is for Aries to allow fear to prevent them from fulfilling their dreams. Then the energy that should have gone into conquering their fears dissipates itself pointlessly and destructively in bursts of temper, silly arguments and random passions.

Where love is concerned Jean and Andrew are likely to be intense, adventurous and experience oriented. In relationship, they need robust contact and a certain amount of psychological arm wrestling with a partner. If the relationship shows signs of going to sleep, one or the other of them will probably rock the boat, perhaps, for example, by picking a fight.

In love, as in every other part of life, Andrew and Jean are learning courage so they had better both be ready to hold up their end of that bargain. They must both be brave enough to tussle head-to-head. These two are likely to be blunt and honest with each other most of the time. They need to guard against pointless fireworks however, or purely symbolic arguments that can needlessly damage both of them, as well as creating a caustic atmosphere of mistrust.

While Jean's main task in life is to find her courage – to challenge herself – at the same time another major theme shown in her chart, is a need to develop her capacity to show empathy, caring and affection, as well as the ability to negotiate and make healthy compromises. These are some of the areas of life she has to be courageous in.

Throughout her life she will simultaneously change and be changed by a handful of human beings with whom she interacts. That is only human nature, but while she does need to flow with others and let herself be affected by them, she needs also to guard against simply going into orbit around them. She must not be SO tuned in to another's needs that she doesn't fully state her own. In reaction to that, in fact, she may at other times doggedly insist on her own point of view. She will however, grow as a person, through mutuality and sharing, and the exercise of

the skills connected with it. Otherwise her energies may be sapped and her growth restricted.

Jean needs a husband who has a well-integrated ego and the capacity to negotiate. But she must develop the ability to state her own needs and to compromise where appropriate. Her trust will be weakened by any instability shown by her partner, or any evasiveness on his part.

The danger for Jean is that she could expect Andrew to be the Aries 'Warrior', and be brave for her. She needs to grasp her courage in her own hands. Her chart indicates that she should have the ability to express herself confidently, and with plenty of energy, in order to achieve her goals. Most probably she would enjoy leadership roles if she is willing to take them on. Certainly she needs positive outlets for her enterprising nature. But her chart also suggests that she can sometimes be a bit lazy and self-indulgent and may need to guard against this. She has creative and artistic potentials, and people will like her. She needs to be brave enough to use these attributes and not waste them.

Andrew should also be able to express himself well, without too much difficulty, but like Jean, at times, he also may have a tendency to be a bit lazy and self-indulgent. Though he may have high expectations of himself, he may have a tendency to over-reach himself, and try to do too much. He would do better if he could be more realistic about how much he can or cannot do, and then try to find a balance. Then it will be easier to achieve his goals. He probably would like a large house and a large family, but again he may need to be as realistic as possible – otherwise it could have a detrimental effect on his health.

Like Jean he can be quite insightful, creative and intuitive and probably attracts people with his warm and sympathetic nature. Both Jean and Andrew however, could become involved in power struggles, not only with people 'out there' but also with each other. They both may need to accept and understand that they are true 'Rams' and hence have to learn about courage by head butting – not only with others, but also with each other!

Jean's Moon is in the sign of Taurus and emphasizes her need for stability and sensuality. Given half a chance a Taurus Moon is simply cuddly! Creature comforts are very important to her and she has a kind of earthy 'chicken soup' reality about relationships and sexuality.

Because her Moon is in Taurus, she needs a degree of peace, and this could lead her to avoid conflict. As I said above, if she and Andrew can accept that their Aries Suns require a degree of head-butting, in order to develop that capacity for courage, while at the same time, Jean has the space and freedom for quiet peaceful times, in secure situations, then danger of the build-up of resentments or frustrations, leading to destructive explosions, can be avoided. She will derive a great deal of comfort domestically from animals, plants and a natural environment. Her emotional well being will be enormously enhanced by living in partnership. Friends are important to her but the real nitty gritty of the matter is the ongoing business of two people creating a life together. To any such union she is capable of bringing sensitivity, commitment, loyalty and a concern for the emotional and physical well being of her partner. She just needs to take care that her own direction in life doesn't get eclipsed by the needs or demands – real or perceived – of Andrew. She needs a partner who is willing and able to share all her emotions, not just the 'acceptable' ones, and also tenderness and nurturing qualities. If he shows any insensitivity to, or dismisses her feelings, it will weaken their relationship.
